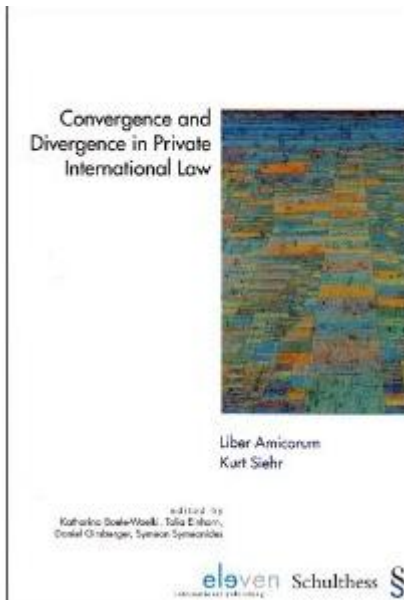


Convergence and Divergence in Private International Law – Liber Amicorum Kurt Siehr
