

European conference on international child abduction, The Hague 7-10 May 2014

On 7-10 May the International Child Abduction Center of the Netherlands (Centre IKO) will host a conference for family lawyers who work in the field of international parental child abduction. The event will take place in the Peace Palace in The Hague.

The conference is part of LEPCA (Lawyers in Europe on Parental Child Abduction), a project funded by the European Commission.
