

International Business Courts – seminar and NCC update

As announced [earlier](#) the seminar Innovating International Business Courts, organized by Erasmus School of Law (ERC project [Building EU Civil Justice](#)), the [Max Planck Institute Luxembourg](#), and the [Montaigne Center](#) of Utrecht University) will take place in Rotterdam on 10 July 2018.
