

Brace yourself: the oral argument of the case *Monasky v. Taglieri* on the HCCH Child Abduction Convention is scheduled for this week before the US Supreme Court

The case [Monasky v. Taglieri](#) will be argued on [Wednesday 11 December 2019](#) at 10:00 a.m. before the US Supreme Court. As you may remember, this case deals with the determination of habitual residence under the [HCCH Child Abduction Convention](#) and may be pivotal in resolving the split in the US circuit courts.
