

Service of Federal Court documents outside Australia

Practitioners in Australia should be aware that, pursuant to [Practice Note No 13](#) (4 September 2008), the Federal Court requires a party applying for leave to serve originating process or other documents outside Australia to support the application with evidence of information obtained from the [Private International Law Section of the Commonwealth Attorney-General's Department](#) in relation to the appropriate method of transmitting documents for service, including certain specified information.
