

Design Tweaks

In an effort to speed up the blog, I have tweaked the design. Most notably, the 'asides' category in the second menu column has disappeared (all those posts can now be found in the main post area with all the others), as indeed has the second menu column itself. All other content from that column has moved into the first column, which you can see to your left.
