

Convention on Taking Evidence in the EU

The Institute for Civil, Comparative and International Private Law of the Faculty of Law in Ljubljana is organising an international conference titled “European Dimension of Taking Evidence in Civil Procedure”. This conference is focused on one of the important topics in the EU law on civil procedure and its various aspects, including the principle of *audiatur et altera pars*, role of the judge in taking evidence, administration and integrity of evidence as well as function of the information technology in the process.
