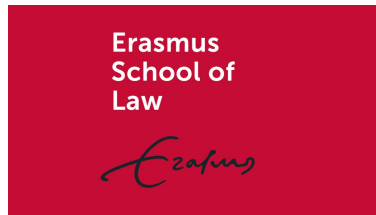


# Five research positions Erasmus School of Law



Erasmus School of Law (Erasmus University Rotterdam) is recruiting five researchers (two postdocs, two PhDs and one parttime associate/endowed/full professor) for the research project **Affordable Access to Justice: towards sustainable cost and funding mechanisms for civil litigation in Europe**.

This five year project is funded by the Netherlands Organisation for Scientific Research (NWO), and led by Prof. [Xandra Kramer](#). This five year project will assess new pathways to civil justice funding and cost schemes, with a view to developing a balanced financing system securing access to justice in Europe.
