

Nagy on collective actions in EU

Recently published paper **The Reception of Collective Actions in Europe: Reconstructing the Mental Process of a Legal Transplantation**, authored by Csongor István Nagy, Professor at the University of Szeged, is a must read for those studying collective actions in EU. It is intended to identify the *differentia specifica* of the European collective actions as opposed to those in US, which in itself is not an easy task as there are various models in different Member States.
