

Out now: Festschrift 40 Jahre IPRG

Celebrating the 40th birthday of the Austrian Private International Law Act, scholars from numerous European countries have contributed to a *festschrift* of more than 400 pages edited by Florian Heindler (Sigmund Freud University Vienna).
