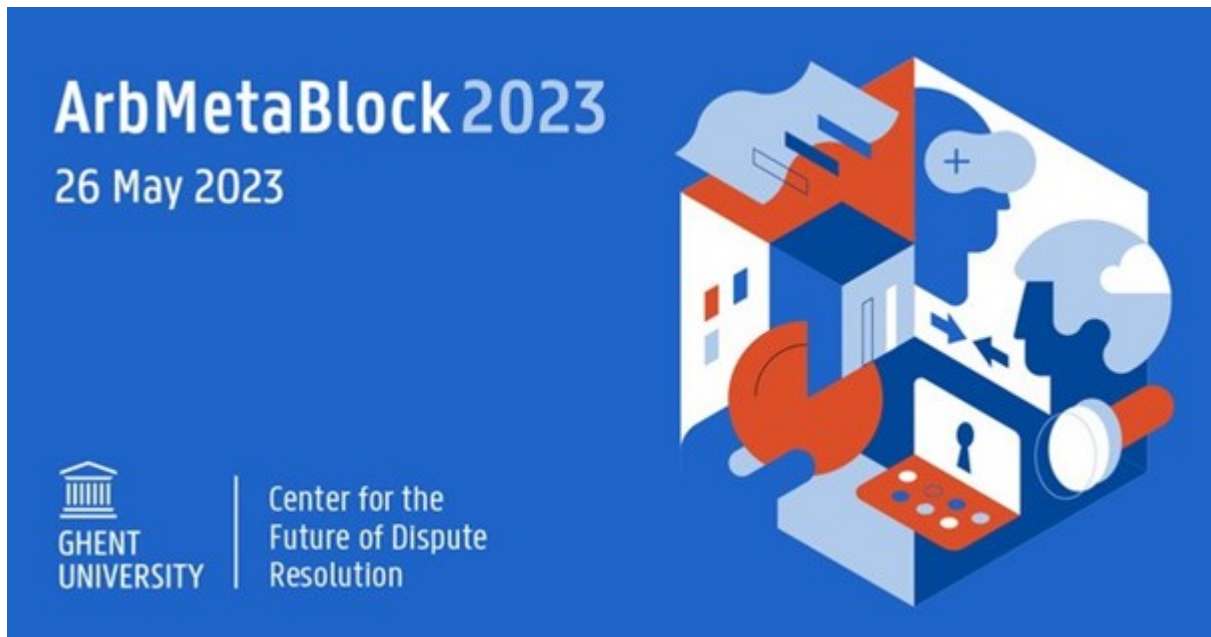


ArbMetaBlock2023 Conference, Ghent, 26 May 2023
