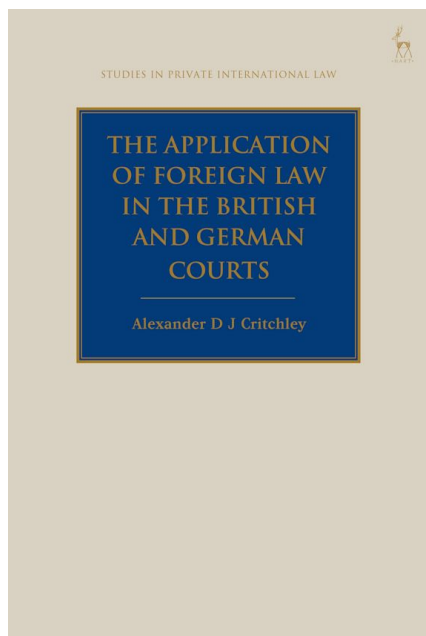


Out Now: Alexander DJ Critchley, The Application of Foreign Law in the British and German Courts

Although the relevant jurisdictions are the focus, the comparative analysis extends to explore examples from other jurisdictions, including relevant international and European conventions. Ambitious in scope, it expertly tracks the development of the law and looks at possible future reforms.
