Candidates should have an original and relevant research agenda and the ability to develop a strong record of high-impact publications in their fields.

Candidates should also have the ability to achieve excellence in their teaching. The successful candidate will be expected to develop innovative and relevant courses within their area of expertise and to teach at least one of the courses of the school's core curriculum, at either undergraduate or postgraduate level.

English is the primary language of instruction within the school's core curriculum, with most courses being imparted from a transnational or comparative law perspective.
