Who can enter?

The ICC Institute Prize is open to candidates under the age of 40 for doctoral dissertations and long essays on international commercial law (including arbitration). Work must be submitted in French or in English and be a minimum of 150 pages.

The prize, including \in 10,000 prize money in recognition of her outstanding work, was handed to Ms Pearson-Wenger during a special award ceremony to conclude the 43rd ICC Institute of World Business Law Annual Conference
